1. Submit ORIGINAL digital photo in preferably JPEG / JPG image format.
2. Amateurs only, no professionals.
3. Entrants must fill out a registration form. By filling out the registration form, entrant agrees to possibly have their work displayed virtually and name in the local media.
4. One image per person per category, unless otherwise specified.
5. Plants & Cut Flowers must be home grown.
6. Culinary Arts entries must be homemade by the exhibitor. Judging will be based on appearance.
7. Entries MUST be the work of the exhibitor and completed in the last two years.
8. Submissions not suitable for family viewing will not be judged or displayed.
9. Judges decisions are FINAL.
10. Judging criteria may include: quality, clarity, originality, composition, presentation, artistry, condition, workmanship, appearance, colour, materials, consistency and attention to details.
11. Remember that the object in the photo is your focus and not your photography skills.
12. Entries will be put into a video/slide show to be shown on social media and housed on the Listowel Fair YouTube channel.
13. Youth are classified as those born on or after January 1, 2008.
